

# About your walk

## Meeting point

Nearly all walks start at Tunsgate Arch, opposite the Guildhall in the High Street



## Except for:

The 'Alan Turing' walk which starts at G-Live, at the far end of Upper High Street and 'Fantastical Mr. Carroll' and 'Lewis Carroll' walks which start at the Town Bridge.

## Time and Distance

Most walks take 90 minutes with a walking distance of half-a-mile. The exceptions being our 3 Queens & 1 Castle walks- 45 to 60 minutes, or The Guildhall tours, up to 60 minutes in length. Nearly all walks start at 11.00 am however if this varies, specific detail is given in the walks programme.

## Are Walks Free?

Almost all the public walks are free. There are two exceptions: Prayers, Plots & Poison and The Fantastical Mr. Carroll which are highlighted in red in the programme\*. For these walks, we make a small charge of £5 per adult (over 16 years old) to offset the cost of the fees that we pay to the performers.

Our walks take place in the open air over mixed terrain. Guildford is built on a hill so please take this into account. Be prepared for the British weather, so bring an umbrella and warm clothes where appropriate!

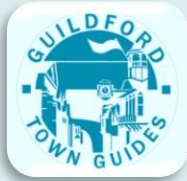

Explore the highlights of our past on a Guildford Story walk. Otherwise, you can select one of the theme walks which go into more depth on some fascinating topics. For a walk with a difference, join one of our encounter walks: Alan Turing, the Fantastical Mr. Carroll or Prayers, Plots & Poison.\* The choice is yours.

We appreciate that our typical 90-minute walks might not be for everyone. If this is the case, look at our *3 Queens & 1 Castle* walks (short walks - 45 to 60 minutes in length) or *The Guildhall* tours (up to 60 minutes in length). We also offer relaxed afterwork walks at 5.30 pm on Friday evenings in June and August for anyone who finds the normal 11 am start time inconvenient.
